- Build consistency of pedagogy by sourcing professional development sessions to meet both whole school and individual teacher priorities
- Implement the two identified Theories of Action – Emphasise Inquiry Teaching & Set Challenging Learning Tasks.

- Implementation of *Curiosity & Powerful Learning* to improve teaching and learning in all classrooms
- Delivery of intensive and targeted literacy and numeracy intervention P-2 program that promotes high levels of learning through flexible approaches and environments
- Increase of student achievement in writing through explicit teaching and formative assessment strategies to track progress, analyse data and provide feedback that informs teaching and learning, and meets whole school achievement targets.
